 - o A letter of recommendation from a teacher, coach, or youth organization leader.
 - A high-resolution photo in headshot/portrait format. The photo will be publicized in announcements and will not affect the application process. Your submission of this photo constitutes your and your parent(s)/guardian(s) permission to use the photo in announcements or other promotional materials.
 - o A YouTube video link or essay response to the essay question (s). Multiple applicants cannot submit the same video. The video must be your original creation.
 - If using YouTube, please set privacy to 'unlisted' and email the link.

- 2. Freeborn Mower Electric Cooperative has seven core values: Integrity, Safety, Quality, Engagement, Teamwork, Community, and Service. What are your core values, and why are they important to you?

Selection:

- All applicants who meet the eligibility requirements will be considered.
- **<u>Preliminary Selection</u>** A judging committee will select up to five (5) applicants to advance to the interview process.
- **Final Selection** The final judging will be in the form of an interview process. (March 11, beginning at 3:30 p.m.) Two applicants will be awarded the Youth Tour Experience, and two applicants will be selected for alternates.
- **Notification** All applicants will be notified of the outcome, as timely as possible.
